Storm Lanterns

Storm lanterns have been part of the collection since 1967. In the course of time they were promoted to all-season furnishing accessories - arranged in clusters out in the garden, in the loggia or inside the house, they display their entire charm. Their shapes are rather large than small. Storm lanterns shield the flame, whose heat can be a hazard to this solid glass product.

Transformation

Crystal storm lanterns are freely shaped by mouth-blowing. Once the glassblower has cut the upper rim, the glass body is held into the fire again to be fire-polished. The slightly irregular bead makes the rim more robust.

Finally the glass candleholder is shaped in the finished glass body. Dimensional variances and slight inclusions are a manifestation of the handcrafted origin of these pieces.

Care

Candles should not be allowed to burn down completely, otherwise the holder may shatter. Filling the lantern with water to just above the holder level will prevent those annoying wax spills.
